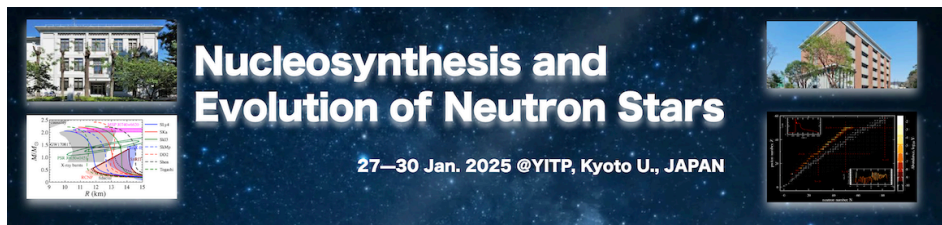

Recent progress on supernova remnants with XRISM X-ray satellite

Supernova remnants (SNRs) are one of the key tools for understanding the SN explosion mechanism and enrichment of the universe. We have launched the X-ray satellite XRISM, which enables us to carry out excellent spectroscopy for extended sources such as SNRs.
